Thesis: I want to show how you ought to let your Savior lead you.

Intro:

1. What does a person gain by allow Christ to lead them?
2. Why do some today not allow Christ to truly lead them?

I. Verse 1

A. What have I to ask beside (v.1a)

1. Christ is always with the Christian and we should not doubt His support (**Heb 13:5**).
2. Too many times someone may doubt Christ, while at the same time showing no faithfulness to Him or even the desire to be faithful to Him.

B. Who through life has been my guide. (v.1b)

1. He is our guide through this life (**Lk 1:79**)
2. Christ is always there for the faithful, however it is man who is sometimes not faithful to him. (**Jn 6:65-67**)

C. For I know what'er be fall me, Jesus doeth all things well (v.1c)

1. Do we know that no matter what comes our way Christ is with us?

II. Verse 2

A. Grace for every trial, feeds me with the living bread (v.2b)

1. We find strength from Christ. (**Rom 1:7b**)
2. Christ is our source for spiritual food.

B. Though we may grow weary, we can be refreshed (v.2c)

1. How are we refreshed? From His Word (**Jn 6:51**).

III. Verse 3

A. Perfect rest is promised, in the Father's house (v.3a)

1. The faithful are promised a perfect rest. Rest unlike that from the world. (**Mt 11:28**)

B. Jesus will lead us all the way, all the way to the Father's house (v.3c)

1. Jesus will lead us by the commands given to Him by God.
2. Through obedience to those commands we gain heaven. (**Jn 14:6**)

2. You can only be lead through obedience to Christ.
