

**Amazing Attributes about God**

Thesis: I want to remind us of some of the amazing attributes of God.

Intro:

1. Everyone has interesting attributes, God especially.
2. God's attributes show us His power and His love for man.

I. Four Points regarding the Nature of God (v.1-18)

- A. He is all-knowing (v.1-6)
  1. A general statement (**Jer 17:9-10**)
  2. Specific areas, emphatically discussed
  3. Application (**Rom 11:33**)
- B. He is all-present (v.7-10).
  1. v.7 – Two questions
  2. v.8-10 – Answers and applications (**Eph 4:6**)
    - a. There is no place where one can escape the control and authority of God.
- C. He is all-seeing (v.11-12)
  1. v.11a – Human reasoning (**Job 24:13-17**)
  2. v.11b-12a – Divine characteristics.
    - a. **2 Chron 16:9, Pro 15:3, 1 Pt 3:12**
  3. 12b - Application
- D. He is all-thinking (v.13-18)
  1. v.13 - “inward parts” – internal controlling power (**Job 10:8-11**)
  2. v.14 – three reasons for praise
  3. v.15 – from conception to birth (“skillfully wrought” – woven or embroidered with threads of different colors)
  4. v.16 – God's view of the process
  - v. 17-18 – Application (**Ps 119:160; 1 Cor 2:9-13**)

II. Two Points of Supplication to God (v.19-24).

- A. Regarding the wicked (v.19-22)
  1. Regarding the wicked.
    - a. First, surely God cannot tolerate all of this.
    - b. Second, regarding me (**2 Pt 2:7; Ps 119:158**)
- B. Regarding me (v.23-24)
  1. Regarding me, I do not want to be wrong.

Conc:

1. God's attributes remind us of who He is.
2. May we never forget the amazing attributes of the God we serve.

**Hear**

Romans 10:17

So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

**Believe**

John 3:16

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever + in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

**Repent**

Luke 13:3

I tell you, no; but unless you repent you will all likewise perish.

**Confess**

Rom 10:9 — Rom 10:10

that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

**Be baptized**

Acts 2:38

Then Peter said to them, “Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Acts 22:16

And now why are you waiting? Arise and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord.’
