I. Why such a question (Lk 13:22-23)

A. Fear of denial of a heavenly entry

- 1. Fear of not going to heaven seems to have at least some part in this question.

B. Who will be saved?

- 1. Who are those who can have eternal life?
- 2. A certain people?
- 3. Requirements?

II. Christ's Answer (Lk 13:24-30)

A. Those who enter through the narrow gate (v.24)

- 1. Those who obey God's word will be able to enter.
- 2. Many "seek to enter and will not be able."
 - a. Even Christ says there are those who won't to follow Him but won't, why?
 - b. Because they are not willing to obey Him (Heb 5:9)

B. Those who God's knows (v.25-28)

- 1. Only those who know God, through obedience, will enter.
- 2. Many "think" or "feel" God knows them, obedience to His will does not enter their minds.

C. From all over the world, the great and the small. (v.29-30)

- 1. Everyone can be a follower of Christ. It does not matter where you live or your culture.
- 2. It does not matter if you are "great" in the eyes of the world, or if your "small".
- 3. God wants the obedient, it matters not if your popular, if your wealthy, or where you are from.

III. Warning & Response

A. Why the warning (Lk 13:31)

- 1. The Pharissees told him to leave because Herod wanted to kill Him.
- 2. Christ, no doubt, was not a stranger to those who wanted to harm Him.

B. Christ's fearless & bold response (Lk 13:32)

- 1. Christ refers to Herod as a "fox". Herod was sly, wicked and deadly.
- 2. Christ responds to this warning by telling the Pharisees to tell Herod what He has done.
- 3. Christ responded in boldness, not with fear.

- 1. Will there be few who are saved?
- 2. We no w know what we must to do be one of those who are saved.
