I. The past repeats itself (**Judges 17:6**)

A. Man has always needed guidance (**Pro 23:18-19**).

1. In the book of Judges man would be faithful only for a time.
2. Man would eventually return to evil thus, a person of God was made to judge over Israel.

B. Man has always struggled with right & wrong.

1. In the garden (**Gen 3**) is an example of how man is weak when faced with temptations.
2. Man has also struggled with peer pressure. Balaam gave into peer-pressure and greed (**Neh 13:2**). Man today hasn't changed much.

II. Man's ways haven't changed (**Prov 21:2**)

A. Man has tested the world (**Ecc 2:1**)

1. Man in Bible times & today has strived for fulfillment from the world.
2. Man has always found that such cannot be found in the world (**Ecc 2:11**)

B. Man has sought happiness & fulfillment by living a wicked sexually.

1. Homosexuality was the lifestyle of some in Bible times just like today. I was condemned then, and still is today (**1 Cor 6:9-10**).
2. He who seeks fulfillment through gratification of the flesh will fall (**Ecc 2:3**).

III. How can the world change (**Deut 12:8**)

A. When the world stops trying to silence God (**Isaiah 30:11**).

1. When the world stops denying God & silencing His Word.
2. When man starts following God's Word then man can change (**James 1:21**).

B. When the world decides to choose "Life" (**Deut 30:19-20**)

1. We choose life when we choose God over the world.
2. We choose life when we choose godliness over the temptations & temporary pleasures of wickedness.

2. Today we have the same choice they did, you must decide what is most important (**Heb 11:24-25**)
