I. Fellow Servants

A. Phoebe (**Rom 16:1-2**)

1. She did many jobs according to Paul.
2. She was a faithful servant that should be helped.
3. She helped many people (**v.2b**)

B. Priscila (**Rom 16:3; Acts 18:2**)

1. Was a fellow worker
2. In some way risked her life for Paul (**Rom 16:4**; some say possibly during the unrest in Ephesus (Acts 19))
2. Assisted in teaching (**Acts 18:24-26**)
  - a. Women can be confident teachers
3. The church met at her house (**Rom 16:5**)

C. Mary (**Rom 16:6**)

1. Bestowed much labor on Paul
  - a. Numerous ways she could have aided him.
    - i. Meals, clothing, a place to sleep, etc

D. Persis (**Rom 16:12**)

1. Only woman with whom Paul used the word “beloved”.
2. She did a lot of work for Paul
3. Her labor was in the Lord.
4. Her service lives on today

E. Rufus’ Mother (**Rom 16:13**)

1. Her name became important because of her son.

II. Lessons for Us Today

A. No labor in the Lord is in vain (**1 Cor 15:58**).

1. Any labor has its ups and downs. However with the Lord, our labor will never be in vain.
2. Our labor requires us to leave some things and people behind so we can further the kingdom (**Mk 10:29-30**).

B. The dead have their works follow them (**Rev 14:13**).

2. Our work in the Lord can live on.
  - a. We must remember this when we are working for the Lord.
