Thesis: I want to show reasons why we can & should trust in Christ.

Intro: 1. Is it easy to find those today whom you can trust?

- 2. Is Christ worthy of your trust?
- I. When Trust rests in those OUTSIDE of Christ.
 - A. Trusting man brings false hope.
 - 1. The commandments of men turns a person from THE truth (**Titus 1:14**)
 - 2. The Apostles, inspired men of God, did not follow such things and neither should we (2 Pt 1:16).
 - B. Trusting in man separates one from Christ.
 - 1. Man often times puts up idols in their hearts. (Ezk 14:3-6)
 - a. These idols sometimes come in the form of setting up teachers of false doctrines as an idol which they will follow to the ends of the earth.
 - 2. We must not be one who follows a blind teacher, or we too, will become blind (**Lk 6:39**).
 - a. Trusting in men only leads to heartache.

II. Trust IN Christ

- A. Trusting in Christ brings abundant living.
 - 1. Christ promised followers a better life (**Jn 10:10**).
 - 2. The Christian life brings joy that the non-Christian will never know (1 Pt 4:3-5).

a. Ecc 2:10-11

- B. Trusting in Christ brings Security
 - 1. Those in Christ do not depart unless they decide to do so themselves (Jn 10:28-29).
 - 2. Those who are in Christ have security that one day they will be with Christ (**Jn 14:1-3**).

III. Lessons for us today.

- A. Christ Alone is worthy of our Trust
 - 1. Paul reminds us of this powerful fact (2 Tim 1:12).
 - 2. Christ has promised us eternal life and He keeps His promises (1 Jn 2:25).
- B. Can Christ Trust You?
 - 1. Can He Trust you to be faithful (**Rev 2:10**)?
 - 2. Can He Trust you to love Him always (**Mk 12:30**)?

Application & Conclusion:

- 1. Have you placed your trust in Christ?
- 2. One cannot gain Heaven and lose the threat of Hell until you place your obedient, trust in Christ.
 - a. This begins by obeying the gospel.
