

**Unshakeable**  
**Psalm 62**

Thesis: I want to show the importance of having an unshakeable faith & trust in God.

Intro: 1. What should man's rock be? Who can man trust? Where can man put his trust?  
a. Psalm 62 shows us David knows where and so can we.

I. God is Salvation

A. God is our Salvation (v.1)

1. **Salvation means being saved, rescued.**
2. **Only God can provide such a thing.**

B. God is worthy of Trust (v.2)

1. **Only God can be trusted with our salvation.**
2. **God is his rock, man is shifting sand.**

II. The Need: Enemies cause us to need to trust in someone

A. How long will his enemies harass him?

1. **All of them will be punished (v.3a)**
2. **Like a leaning fence, sooner or later they will fall (v.3b)**

B. The goal of his enemies. (v.4)

1. **Their goal was to bring down the righteous.**
2. **To harass, hinder and mock.**

III. The Solution: I will Trust in God, and So Should You

A. **David reminds himself to trust in God (v.5)**

B. **David proclaims his trust in God (v.6-7)**

C. **David recommends others to trust in God, to pour out their heart to Him (v.8)**

IV. The Warning: The Way of Sin is not trustworthy.

A. Man is nothing in comparison to God (v.9)

1. **Man often times cannot be trusted.**

B. Vanity of trusting Man's wicked ways

1. **Sinful ways of prosperity are not pleasing to God (v.10a)**
2. **Do not trust in such sinful gains (v.10b)**

V. The Conclusion: Keep Hearing His message and rely on Him

A. God's message hasn't changed

1. **The message that is given to one is also given to another (v.11a)**
2. **By "twice I have heard this" shows that man must be willing to continue to listen to God (v.11b)**

B. A reminder of repayment (v.12)

1. **God is merciful and just.**
2. **God will repay those who work wickedness.**

## VI. Lessons for Us Today

**A. Never forget where your trust should be (v.1-2, 6-7).**

**B. Encourage others to do the same (v.8)**
