What to do, When You Don't Know What to do Psalm 139:7-12

Thesis: I want to show the importance of preparing for the unexpected.

Intro: 1. The Bible reveals that troublesome times and good times come to all men (Mt 5:45b).

- I. Remember that hard & uncertain times will come
 - A. Sickness, death, and unpredictable events do happen.
 - 1. Difficult times for mankind are seen in the Bible (Mt 9:18, 15:22; Lk 7:2).
 - 2. Hard times do not automatically drive people to unfaithfulness (Gen 50:20).
 - B. The Bible warns of such times.
 - 1. Life is hard sometimes (Ecc 2:17,23)
 - 2. The Christian lives on the promises of God, not on the faulty reasoning or explanations of man (**Job 38:2**).

II. Remember God is Always Present

- A. We have no reason to doubt God's presence.
 - 1. Where can I go? (**Psalm 139:7-12**)
 - 2. Never far from us (Acts 17:27).
- B. Call upon Him
 - 1. God's presence commands us to call upon Him (Ps 50:15).
 - 2. Jesus also turned to God in difficult time and we should follow His example.
 - a. Prior to being betrayed by Judas Christ prayed to the Father three times.

III. Remember God remembers and rescues us

- A. God never forgets His servants.
 - 1. Noah faced great difficulties and God never forgot him (Gen 8:1, Ps 106:4).
 - 2. Just because man may feel forgotten doesn't mean God has truly forgotten him (Ps 13:1-6).
- B. God rescues us when we Trust in Him
 - 1. God rescues us from troubled times (Ps 144:7a).
 - 2. When we delight in God, thus trusting in Him, He will rescue us (Ps 22:8).
 - a. Psalm 50:15-22

IV. Lessons for Us Today

- A. Proper faith before trials begin
 - 1. We must prepare for the storm before it hits (**Job 3:26**).
 - 2. Trouble comes when we do not expect it (**Job 30:26-27**).
- B. Listening to God
 - 1. We must listen to God (His word) in good times & bad.
 - a. If we don't should we expect Him to listen to us? (Pro 1:24-26).
 - 2. We must know God now whether we are standing in the rain or the sunshine.

Application & Conclusion:

- 1. A prepared Christian is the one who will reach Heaven.
- 2. The unprepared, as scripture reveals, will struggle to do so.
- 3. Full Invitation
